#### Springfield Whole Foods Relocating...to Springfield!

Whole Foods' 8402 Old Keene Mill Road location is moving to Springfield Plaza, 7025 Old Keene Mill Road on October 4<sup>th</sup>. The new location will have roughly double the square footage, providing regional farm-sourced produce, specialty cheeses, and a selection of more than 300 craft beers!

# Alexandria City Council Reconsiders Special Events Policy.

Under current Alexandria policies, special events are not permitted on back-to-back weekends in Old Town. The town council has the authority to waive this restriction on a case-by-case basis. However, the council is now deliberating on loosening these restrictions, to allow events on consecutive weekends in Old Town.

## Thousands in Fairfax County Wrongfully Ticketed for Speeding.

Drivers in Fairfax received improper citations from speed cameras installed in school zones in multiple locations in Fairfax. The root cause could be traced to malfunctioning school zone signs, which advise drivers of reduced speed when lights are flashing. Since the lights were malfunctioning, drivers were correctly driving at the standard speed. However, speed cameras ticketed them for failing to observe the reduced speed. Police say 2,800 tickets were issued, and refunds are pending. Angry residents, however, say they are still awaiting refunds after paying their fines.
